

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

8414.3

The Board of Education views each school bus as an extension of the classroom. Rules for student conduct shall, therefore, be uniform with rules established for the conduct of students in all other school activities. Student bus conduct shall support the maintenance of a high degree of safety, the comfort of fellow passengers, the respect of motorists on the highway, and respect for public and private property throughout the bus route.

The Superintendent of schools shall establish such rules and regulations as may be needed to carry out this policy. Although these rules and regulations will specifically address the issue of conduct on school buses, they shall also support and be in conformance with the general Board policy concerning student conduct - Policy #5300.
