

The news media represent the public interest in reporting information concerning the Johnson City Central School District. It is, therefore, in the interests of both the education community and the citizens of the school district that there is free and open communication at all times with the news media.

It is the policy of the District that the Superintendent/designee will be the spokesperson for the School District.

The superintendent shall prescribe the procedures for the delivery of notices of meetings and agendas to the news media. Bona fide representatives of the media not currently receiving their notices may request that they receive such notices.

State laws require notices to be publicized. The Board designates the Press and Sun Bulletin as the official newspaper where notice is required.
