Analyze enrollment projections and staffing levels Formulate budget goals and solicit budget requests


Review program needs with department and school administrators

- ♦ Expanding support personnel to address staff and student needs
 - ♦ High Impact Tutoring
 - ♦ Everyday subs
 - ♦ Additional School counselor(s)
 - ♦ Teaching assistants at the High School (Transition program)
 - ♦ Enrichment coordinator
 - ♦ Add CTE teacher for culinary program
 - ♦ Review Non Instructional benefits opportunities
 - ♦ Strategic transitional plan for leadership- Elementary School and Transportation
- Special Education costs
- ♦ Contractual salary and benefit increases
- Increasing health insurance costs
- ♦ Inflationary increases in contractual, material and operational costs
- ♦ Transportation costs

Revenues	\$68,372,652
Proposed Tax Levy Increase	0.0%

Next Steps

- ♦ Monitor and re-assess revenues once the State Budget is adopted (approximately April 1st)
- Continue to review opportunities to support students and accelerate student learning

Proposition 1- Bus Purchases



2-66 passenger buses-\$334,296.06

1-66 passenger electric bus \$405,800.38

(dependent on grant funding \$200,000)

1- Suburban \$70,000

Net cost to district \$81,025

*The list of buses to trade are outside the 10 year warranty period

Bus #156 - 66 passenger, 13 years old, 141,333 miles

Bus #162 - 66 passenger, 11 years old, 144,123 miles

Bus #155 - 66 passenger, 14 years old, 87,650 miles Scrapped as a requirement of the NYSERDA program 85% aid received on total purchase
